General Role Description

Key Responsibilities

- Oversee daily jobsite performance and execution for project delivery to the client:
 - Build a job site team environment through communicating, managing and collaborating with jobsite personnel and specialty contractors
 - Schedule specialty contractor, vendors, owner furnished items etc.
 - Onsite QA/QC inspection
 - Attend and participate in OAC project meetings
 - Jobsite safety inspections and enforcement
 - Complete project in the allotted time frame of our contract/bid
